COPYRIGHT (UNIVERSAL COPYRIGHT CONVENTION) ORDER, 1985

This order was made on 20th May, 1985 by the Minister under section

50 of the Copyright Act.

Commencement: 30th May, 1985.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Copyright (Universal Copyright Convention) Order, 1985.
- 2. For the purposes of this order the "Universal Copyright Convention" means the Universal Copyright Convention done at Geneva on 6th September, 1952 and revised at Paris on 24th July, 1971.
- 3. The *Copyright Act* applies to literary, artistic and scientific Cap. 300. works
 - (a) of foreign authors first published in a country that has acceded to the Universal Copyright Convention, or
 - (b) of authors who are citizens of or resident in a country, other than Barbados, that has acceded to the Universal Copyright Convention, if the works are unpublished.
