## The Business Names Rules, 1940

Dated June 27th, 1940, made by His Honour Ernest Allan Collymore, Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, pursuant to Section 18 of the Registration of Business Names Act, 1940.

These Rules may be cited as the Business Names Rules, 1940, and shall come into operation from and immediately after June, 1940.

The Act means the Registration of Business Names Act, 1940. Whenever any act is by the Act required to be done by the Registrar such act shall be done by the Registrar or the Deputy Registrar or anyone duly appointed to act in their stead.

#### Procedure under Section 16

Where the Registrar, pursuant to Section 16 (1) of the Act, decides to refuse to register any business name or, as the case may be, to remove any business name from the register, he shall send by registered part to the registered part to the register of part and part to secure the register of the registered part to the registered part to the register of t registered post to the firm or individual applying for registration or, as the case may be, registered in respect of such business name, a notice in writing of such decision, and such notice shall contain a statement that any person aggrieved by such decision may appeal to the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas within twenty one days of such notice.

5. If within twenty one days from the date of the notice of a decision of the Registrar under Section 16 (1) of the Act to remove a business name from the register no notice of appeal is received from such decision of the Registrar, and if on appeal such decision of the Registrar is upheld, the Registrar shall remove such business

name from the register in accordance with his decision. 6. Any person intending to appeal to the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas from any decision of the Registrar under Section 16 (1) shall, within twenty one days of the date of the notice of such decision, send by registered post or deliver to the Registrar a notice of appeal in writing in the prescribed form. Such notice shall be accompanied by a statement of the grounds of appeal and of the

appellant's case in support thereof.

7. The Registrar shall, on receipt of such notice of appeal together with the prescribed documents, notify the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall fix a time and date for the hearing of such appeal at which the appellant and the Registrar may attend and be heard. If the appellant does not attend or is not represented during the hearing of such appeal the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas may proceed to adjudicate on the matter. hearing may be postponed or adjourned.

8. The decision of the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas shall be communicated to the appellant in writing by the

Registrar.

9. The time prescribed in these rules for doing any act thereunder by or to the Registrar may be enlarged by the Chief Judge of the Court of Common Pleas upon such terms as he may direct, and such enlargement may be granted though the time has expired for doing such act.

10. The fees to be paid to the Registrar under the Act are as

follows:-

(a) On a Statement of Particulars required by Section 5 of the Act the sum of five shillings, and such fee shall

cover the issue of one certificate of registration.

(b) On any Statement of Particulars required by the Schedule to the Act when such particulars are not furnished with the Statement of Particulars required by Section 5 of the Act the sum of five shillings; and such fee shall cover the issue of one certificate of registration.

(c) On any statement of any change within the meaning of Section 8 of the Act the sum of two shillings and sixpence, and such fee shall cover the issue of one certificate of the registration of such statement.

(d) By any person inspecting under the provisions of Section 17 of the Act the documents filed by the Registrar,

the sum of one shilling for each inspection.

(e) On the application of any person requiring under the provisions of Section 17 of the Act a certificate of registration of any firm, individual or corporation or a certified conv. of or extract for the sum of copy of or extract from any registered statement the sum of two shillings for a certificate of registration, and for any other entry, copy or extract the sum of sixpence per folio of seventy two words of the entry, copy or extract, but not exceeding one shilling.

(f) By any person appealing to the Chief Judge of the

Court of Common Pleas the sum of one pound.

All forms prescribed by the act or these rules shall conform with the forms in the appendix to these rules with such adaptations or variations as in the opinion of the Registrar may be necessary.
